The powerful RaptorID™ engine allows for nearly unlimited attribute configurations, meaning it can be used by multiple jurisdictions in the same area, as well as a wide range of other customers, not just emergency services.

RaptorID™ is intended for the First Responders market, which includes EMS, Fire, Police, Red Cross, Telecommunication Workers, Heavy Equipment Operators, and Volunteers. RaptorID™ was developed to meet the demands of regulatory requirements of:

Main Features

RaptorID™ Express is an Out-of-the-box credentialing solution for First Responders that allows Incident Commanders to know who is on the scene and what skills they have so they can be put on task quickly and efficiently.

RaptorID™ credentials identity profile has been aligned to FIPS 201 standards. This allows the RaptorID™ credential to be interoperable with any federally compliant government reader and likewise the RaptorID™ hardware can read Department of Defense Common Access Cards, federal FIPS, and National Capitol Region First Responder Access Cards.



The RaptorID™ Express can be augmented with a field kit to support local regional or even national resource management, accountability, and scene control operations. RaptorID™ is also available on an enterprise level to support multi-jurisdictional consortiums, large cities and counties, and statewide deployments.

The issued credential is in the form of a full color PVC smart card. The card is printed edge to edge utilizing HDP Dye-Sublimation / Reverse Resin Thermal Transfer technology. The card comes in a standard layout following the topography requirements of the Federal Information Processing Standard 201. A customer provided logo or seal can be added to the card template. The front of the card is overlaid with a world view hologram for added security. The card will be mailed directly to the credential holder, and can be activated online. An alternate delivery method has all of the agency's cards delivered at once. Packages include:
